The ASPAN Perianesthesia Pain and Comfort Clinical Guideline is designed to serve as a guideline for clinicians and multiple clinical practitioners. The guideline is packaged in a Pain and Comfort Resource Manual designed to provide needed pain and comfort information for practitioners as well as patients.

### ASPAN Clinical Practice Guideline: Pain and Comfort

The consensus process included teleconferences, surveys of the entire PN safety committee, and input from multiple ASPEN committees and the ASPEN Board of Directors. ASPEN defines the adult population to be above the age of 18 years old, the pediatric population to be between 28 days and 18 years old, and the neonatal population to be younger than 28 days.
