When the musician presses a key on his keyboard, it generates MIDI data -- which key he pressed, how long he held it down, how hard he pressed it -- that tells the other instruments exactly what notes to play and how to play them.

How does MIDI work? No audio signals (sounds) are sent via MIDI. Instead MIDI works as a digital signal. A series of binary digits (0s and 1s). Each instrument (or computer) understands and then responds to these 1s and 0s, which are combined into 8-bit messages supporting data rates of up to 31,250 bits per second.

The wonder of MIDI is that it doesn't actually record sound like a tape recorder would, but rather it uses a tool called a sequencer that records only data that was used to create the sound. For example, when you play your keyboard the sequencer records that you played middle "C" for 1 beat and you hit the key with a certain velocity and then you played a "D" for 3 beats and you hit the key ...

General MIDI General MIDI (GM) is not an advanced form of MIDI but simply an agreement between musical instrument manufacturers about which sounds will occupy which preset slots in a GM instrument. For example, Preset 1 is always an acoustic grand piano, 7 is a harpsichord, 41 is a violin and so on.
