PART III - UNECE

The international transport of dangerous goods by road is subject to international legislation, in particular the European Agreement on the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road. Drivers of vehicles carrying dangerous goods must hold an ADR training certificate in handling dangerous goods.
